From the Pemi newsletter:

The annual "Mud Season Match" is a very informal match to shake off the winter doldrums, and most shooters dig into their rifle safes and pick out the least-used center-fire rifle.

The match has two parts. The first is a 40-shot match – two strings of 20 shots each – all standing, fired one shot at a time. We squad up starting at 8:30am and hope to get the first shot off at 9:00am.

The optional second part, aka "the bonus round" is a 1-shot "winner take all" match. Each shooter puts \$5 into the pot. The person who puts that 1 shot closest to the middle wins the pot. However, if someone hits the Tannerite hidden somewhere on the target, it's game over and that person wins the pot right then.

Given the wide variety of rifles brought to the match (which is part of the fun), we set up two categories: one is "modern sporting rifles" (which is mostly AR-15s), and the other is "good ol' wood and steel".
